An essay (maximum 500 words) describing your career goals and how you plan to meet those goals; the skills and abilities you will bring to your internship at the Memorial Art Gallery. **Please address why a gallery space in a working art school division of the gallery interests you and why you are qualified.**

There are a limited number of internship slots available. Selected applicants may be interviewed and considered for placement based on the needs of the Gallery as well as the candidate's interests and experience. In addition to assigned internship duties, attempts will be made to introduce students to various aspects of museum work. Please note that availability of internship positions is determined by the needs of the Gallery. Every effort will be made to accommodate a preference; **all internship opportunities are valuable and worthwhile.**

The application deadlines for 2017 are:

SPRING APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED UNTIL FEBRUARY 15, 2017 or until position filled! We hope to have another Spring intern identified by February 15, 2017.

SUMMER APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED UNTIL MAY 2, 2017 or until positions filled! We hope to have as many as 2 college interns identified by May, 2017.

FALL APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED UNTIL JUNE 15, 2017 or until positions filled!

We hope to have as many as 2 college interns identified by August 15, 2017. We traditionally bring in one intern before our Clothesline Festival (September 9 & 10, 2017) and one after classes start near the end of September. Both will work until December 2017.
