



Supply List for Illustration and Cartooning

This class teaches the principals and practice of illustration and cartooning and comic drawing. Within industry standards and printing concerns, you will make creative decisions that work with your ideas. Drawings will grow with coaching, in this class emphasis is on understanding and creating a visually satisfying image or story.

We recommend you bring any of the following materials you already have to the first session of your class.

If you do not have materials for the first class, please do not fret, we will have some of these to experiment with so that you can buy only what you will use.

MATERIALS COMMONLY USED FOR BOOK ILLUSTRATION:

- Water-soluble crayons or watercolor pencils
- Graphite pencils or pastels
- Sharpie markers or other permanent markers-fine point and wide tip
- Acrylic or watercolor paints and brushes

PAPERS:

- At least 90lb, paper-suitable for wet media

OTHER:

- Any personal preferred drawing media
