Painting Student List for all painting classes taught by Dale Klein Spring & Summer 2021 at the Creative Workshop

Materials will be discussed at first class meeting. Beginning students may want to start with acrylics.

BRUSHES- synthetic if using acrylic, bristle if using oils

Rounds #2, #6, round brushes that say for acrylic and oils (long handles)

Flats: #4, #8 flat brushes (long handles) #10 (optional) flat brush (long handle)

CONTAINERS-

For acrylics: two containers (i.e. yogurt or cans) for water: one for cleaning brush, one for painting.

For Oils: Glass container with screw top. (for mineral spirits)

RAGS OR PAPER TOWELS - for cleaning brushes and wiping off excess paint or water

DRAWING MEDIA- #2 pencil, vine charcoal, eraser (white or kneaded) and either masking tape or artist tape

ODORLESS MINERAL SPIRITS (Gamsol or other artist' mineral spirits) **OR VEGETABLE OIL** for cleaning up oils.

DISHWASHING SOAP - for cleaning brushes, there will be some in the room. **PAINTING**

KNIFE - 1 palette knife, tapered to mix paints and scrape paint off.

MEDIUMS For Acrylic: Matt Medium - increases flow of paint and enhance the depth and vibrancy of color. Helps the paint become more transparent can build up with thin glazes.

For Oils: Liquin or Gamblin alkyd medium or Linseed Oil

PALETTE COLORS: Good brands are: Golden, Liquitex, Dick Blick and Windsor Newton. You can use student grade.

Cadmium Yellow Hue, medium
Yellow Ochre (optional)
Cadmium Red Hue, medium
Alizarin Crimson
Burnt Umber
Raw Umber (optional)

Burnt Sienna
Viridian or similar Green
Cobalt Blue Ultramarine
Blue Ivory Black
Dioxazine Purple (optional)
Cadmium Orange Hue (optional)

PALETTE TO MIX COLORS - Paper Palette Pad for acrylic paints and oils. SURFACE to work on - 9x12" or larger: Canvas Pad and several Canvas Boards Sheet of White Bristol Board (for beginning painting only)
