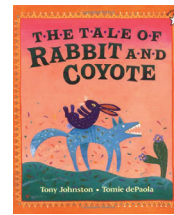

For ages 2–6 with accompanying adult.

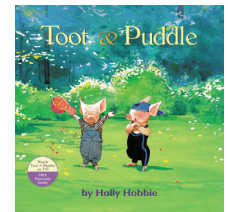

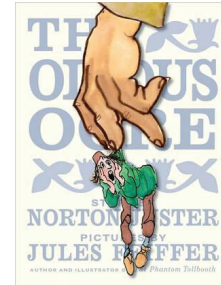

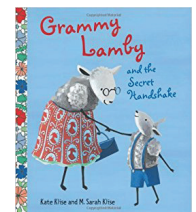
