We are looking for artwork made in Creative Workshop classes. Adult students are warmly encouraged to submit up to **two pieces for the show**. These artworks will be proudly displayed during our Fall session. Burne Gallery shows are enjoyed by many visitors to the MAG.

All artworks submitted must be **ready to hang**. By ready to hang, we mean: with hanging wires if it is a painting, matted or framed to your aesthetic and protected (covered with glass or Plexiglas for protection.) We do reserve the right to save wall/pedestal space for first time exhibitors, or limit pieces due to size.

Details: Our Waning Summer/Crisp Fall Adult Student Show will be on view in the Lucy Burne Gallery approximately from October 5, 2017– October 26, 2017

We request that works are submitted by 4pm on Saturday September 23, 2017. Artwork can be dropped off any time the Creative Workshop is open. During the drop off period the Creative Workshop is open Monday through Friday from 9am-5pm; and during Clothesline Weekend September 9th and 10th from 10:30- 4:30. We will be closed on September 1, 2017.

While the Lucy Burne Gallery provides no insurance for artwork, we treat all art with care.

- Paintings may be submitted unframed; however, if you wish to protect your artwork we strongly suggest framing it. We can provide suggestions for low cost yet professional display.
- Work may be for sale (the Memorial Art Gallery takes no sales commission, it also does not sell the work, we simply pass on your contact information to interested potential buyers).
