In addition to its extensive permanent collection, there are two special exhibits "Glass of the Architects" and the newly redesigned Crystal City Gallery.

The rest of the day, you will be able to visit the museum at your leisure, view the "gaffers" (glass blowers) in the newly constructed Hot Box Amphitheater, and take a stroll on the absolutely stunning promenade and visit the gift shop. (You may want to bring your holiday list) and lunch in the GMOG cafeteria.

Are you looking for more of an adventure? Go into town for lunch and/or visit artists' studios and art galleries on Market Street, take the free shuttle from CMOG. The shuttle runs every 20 minutes making it easy to visit the Gaffer District. For those who like to walk, Market Street is an easy stroll from the museum.
