Call for artwork from current or recent Creative Workshop students!

We are looking for artwork made in Creative Workshop classes or inspired by instruction at the CW. Adult and teen students are warmly encouraged to submit up to **two pieces for the show**. **These artworks will be proudly displayed in the Lucy Burne Gallery between October 6 and November 3, 2020.** These shows are enjoyed by many visitors to the MAG. This year we will also have an online exhibit accompanying the show. **The online exhibit will go live on or before October 15 and stay online until the end of January 2021.**

All artworks submitted in person must be **ready to hang**. By ready to hang, we mean artwork is outfitted with either hanging wires or D-rings or a sturdy hook. We strongly recommend that artwork is also covered with glass or Plexiglas for protection, and matted or framed to your aesthetic. We do reserve the right to save wall/pedestal space for first time exhibitors, or limit pieces due to size.

We request that all physical artworks are submitted by Wednesday September 30. All artwork must be submitted with a completed submission form (next page). Works can be dropped off at any time the Creative Workshop is open. Call 276-8959 or 276-8956 for hours the CW is open.

If you are interested in submitting your work, please note the following:

- While the Lucy Burne Gallery provides no insurance for artwork, we treat all art with care.
- Paintings may be submitted unframed; however, if you wish to protect your artwork we strongly suggest framing it. We can provide suggestions for low cost yet professional display.
- Work may be for sale (the Memorial Art Gallery takes no sales commission, it also does not sell the work, we simply pass on your contact information to interested potential buyers).
